Volunteer Position at Bike Recycle Vermont: Senior Bicycle Mechanic

Our mission is to expand opportunities for low-income Vermonters of all ages by providing participants skills training and sustainable mobility via refurbished bicycles.

GENERAL OVERVIEW

We are seeking volunteers to help the BRY repair and refurbish bicycles for low income Vermonters. The senior mechanic position is for bike mechanics with previous bike shop experience and/or extensive bike repair experience. In addition to doing bike repairs, Senior Mechanics may assist less experienced volunteers.

Roles and Responsibilities

- *Assist in repairs and refurbishments on bicycles.*
- *Teach and help less experienced volunteers, if interested*
- *Perform light duty repairs for customers (flat fixes, small adjustments, etc.)*
- *Receive repairs and do basic estimates (refer to price list)*

*Tuesday through Friday 9 am - 5 pm, to be scheduled in advance (no drop-ins).
Third Saturday from 9 am - 1 pm (known as the "BRY Bike Jam")*
